There are three different numbering systems for the books first displayed in 1963 as 'Printing and the Mind of Man'. The system in general use at present (November 2023) is the one used for the 1967 catalogue. However, that catalogue lacked many of the entries for 1963 and included several new ones. The Lilly exhibition of 1973 introduced further complications with the numbering. In this table will be found all the numbering systems, details of books added for 1967, details of cataloguing errors and all the titles from the Ian Fleming Collection exhibited in 1963.
